
Remember that there are things all of us can do working together to mitigate the damage:

- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available use alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid contact with sick people.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Practicing social distancing (no less than 6ft. a part) at all times when around other people.
- Limit group gatherings to no more than 10 people while continuing to practice social distancing.


