AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF REAL PROPERTY, OWNED BY CLARENDON COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA AND IDENTIFIED AS CLARENDON COUNTY TAX MAP PARCEL NO.: 197-12-05-013-00.

- 3. All owners, their successors, heirs and/or assigns assume all responsibility regarding title and agree to hold County, its successors and/or assigns harmless from any and all liability relating to the transfer of Parcel(s) by County to owner(s).
- 4. County Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, employ any and all professionals and make squared any and all decisions to effectuate the transfer and closing of Parcelled 1202
