RELATING TO UNIFORM SERVICE CHARGES AND THEIR APPLICATION IN LIGHT OF *BURNS V. GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL*; AND RELATED MATTERS.

THE CLARENDON COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY COUNCIL RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. Findings.

WHEREAS, the County is a political subdivision of the State of South Carolina ("State") and possesses all powers granted to political subdivisions by the Constitution and general laws of the State;

WHEREAS, the South Carolina Supreme Court ("Court"), in *Burns v. Greenville County Council*, Appellate Case No. 2018-002255, has issued Opinion No. 28041, filed June 30, 2021 ("Opinion"), which calls into question the validity of certain of Greenville County's "uniform service charges" as described in the Opinion and in South Carolina Code Annotated sections 4-9-30(5)(a), 6-1-300, and 6-1-330;

WHEREAS, the Court may determine to rehear the case and/or provide additional guidance on the Opinion's impact on uniform service charges not specifically mentioned in the Opinion and/or for jurisdictions not specifically covered by the Opinion; and

WHEREAS, the County Council, without determining the Opinion's applicability to any uniform service charge imposed in the County, desires to take this temporary action in response to the Opinion.

SECTION 2. Pre-1997 Imposition. The County Council directs that the Road Maintenance Fee imposed in the County be imposed in the manner and at the rate as provided before 1997.

SECTION 3. Reliance. The County Council authorizes all County elected and appointed officials to rely on this Resolution in the billing, collecting, and allocating of uniform service charges.

SECTION 4. Additional Authorization. The County Council authorizes the County Administrator and his designee(s) to provide additional information to County elected and appointed officials and to take additional actions as may be necessary and proper to carry out this Resolution's intent.

SECTION 5. General Repealer. Each resolution, or order of County Council, or any part of the same in conflict with this Resolution, is to the extent of that conflict, repealed.
