Chairman Stewart stated that after this is done, he will get with Lynden Anthony get it signed and distributed.

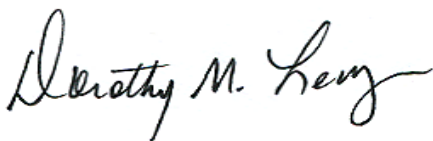
#### **4. Adjourn**
