

Clarendon County Names Interim County Administrator

On Thursday, July 17th, 2025 at a Special Called meeting, Clarendon County Council voted unanimously in favor of naming Sharmane Anderson the Interim County Administrator. Her appointment comes on the retirement of the Administrator Lynden Anthony while the search for his successor begins in earnest.

Sharmane Anderson's elevation to the role of Interim County Administrator is a testament to her career in public service and her commitment to the well-being of Clarendon County's residents. Having served the community most recently as Clarendon County Deputy Administrator, Anderson brings a wealth of experience and an understanding of the county's unique needs and challenges.

Anderson, a Clarendon native, was originally hired as Executive Director of the Clarendon County Voter Registration and Elections office and became Deputy County Administrator in 2023. She received her undergraduate degree in political science from Francis Marion University, master's degree from Clemson and a Juris Doctor from Charleston School of Law.
